Surat: A team of Surat range IGP office arrested two persons from Kosamba in Surat district on Sunday for allegedly dealing in counterfeit currency notes. Police recovered fake notes of Rs 25,45,000 face value from the accused in Rs 500 and Rs 2,000 denomination.

Police arrested Naran Solanki,

58, a resident of Kosamba and Prashant alias Raju Patel, 47, a resident of Borbhatha village in Surat, for allegedly printing and dealing in counterfeit currency notes. One accused Shashikant Bhavshankar, a resident of Jahangripura area in city, is yet to get arrested.
