TRENDING After Mumbai, Fake Hand Sanitizer Manufacturing Unit Busted Near Gurugram. 5000 Bottles Seized

In Harayana, the Food and Drug Administration busted a fake hand sanitizer manufacturing company and seized at least 5,000 hand sanitizers.

The bottles of these so-called sanitizers were being sold under the name of Viro-rub. Around 1,000 liters of isopropyl alcohol (IPA) was also seized from the manufacturing unit.

Amandeep Chauhan, Drugs Control Officer told *The Tribune*, "They had already sold 2,500 bottles of the sanitiser in the market before the FDA authorities could get a tip-off and raid the unit."
