

# Police probe fake RGPV mark-sheets seized

BHOPAL: After seizing fake mark-sheets of Rajiv Gandhi Prodyogiki Vishwavidyalaya (RGPV) from an accused in the DMAT scam investigators at the Kolar police station are trying to correlate between the fake mark-sheets seized and those downloaded from internet.

The RGPV authorities had handed over a student from Andhra Pradesh recently to the Gandhi Nagar police station with a fake mark-sheet downloaded from the internet.

According to Gandhi Nagar police station a student from Andhra Pradesh was cheated by unknown persons on a website who issued him a fake mark-sheet. "A student from Vijayawada bought an RGPV mark-sheet online by paying Rs 80,000. The downloaded mark-sheet, however, was declared fake by the RGPV when he went to the university to verify its authenticity. On his complaint, a case under 420 IPC was registered against the unknown persons operating the portal," said Jitendra Patel SHO Gandhi Nagar police station.

Officers at Gandhi Nagar police station has also decided to send a team to Vijayawada for further inquiry. "Victim hails from Vijayawada and he received mark-sheet in the same city. We will send his complaint to Vijayawada for inquiry," said Patel.

Meanwhile, RGPV has clarified that fake-mark-sheets have no connection with the university. "We have a secure system. We have immediately informed the police after the incident," said vice-chancellor of RGPV, Professor Piyush Trivedi. RGPV has also given the internet fake mark-sheet matter to cyber crime cell of the state police for investigations.
