

Two arrested for forging marksheets in Gurgaon

GURGAON: Two men have been arrested for allegedly forging marksheets with 400 blank marksheets recovered from their possession by the police.

The two were arrested separately on February 12 and 15 from Sukhrali village. A resident tipped off Sector 18 police that his tenants were

involved in printing illegal marksheets. Police said, Gautam, who was arrested on February 12, tipped off the cops about his partner Gurvinder Singh.

An FIR under sections 420 (cheating) and 120B (punishment of criminal conspiracy) has been filed against the duo. Blank marksheets of various institutions, including 147 of Delhi Board, 136 of Karnataka Open University, 47 of Sikkim University, 39 of Manav Bharti University, 20 of Sun Rise University in Alwar, 20 of Shridhar University in Pilani and 13 of Monad University in Hapur were recovered, among others.

“We’re investigating the matter and trying to track down the source from where they got the blank marksheets,” said inspector Amit Kumar, SHO at Sector 18 police station.
