Man held for selling fake cosmetics

AMBALA: Police here have arrested a person under various sections of the IPC, Trademark Act, and Copyright Act for allegedly selling fake products of Hindustan Unilever Limited (HUL) company on Wednesday.

The accused has been identified as Rajesh Kumar, a resident of Vita Colony, Dhulkote village in Ambala

district.

The accused was presented before the court on Thursday, which sent him to oneday police remand.

As per the information, Yogeshwar Prasad, a manager and researcher at HUL received a tip-off that Rajesh supplies fake cosmetic products after pasting trademarks of HUL. Following the tip-off, Prasad lodged a complaint with the Ambala police.

On Wednesday, the accused was booked under sections 63 and 65 of the Copyright Act, sections 103 and 104 of the Trademark Act, and sections 420, 482, 483 and 486 of the Indian Penal Code at Panjokhra police station of Ambala district.

Panjokhra station house officer (SHO) inspector Surender Singh said, "The accused has been taken to one-day police remand to ascertain further details about the chain involved in this practice. A large quantity of fake cosmetic products and other trademark and copyright-related items have been seized from the possession of accused. Further investigation into the matter is being done."
