

Fake currency notes worth nearly Rs 14,000 seized in Bihar, two nabbed

Kishanganj, Feb 23 (UNI) Police seized fake currency notes worth nearly Rs 14,000 and arrested two peddlers from Pothia Basti locality under Sadar police station area in the district on Saturday.

The accused were identified as Mohammed Salim (14) and Mohammed Nurul (28) Police said

According to the Police, fake currency notes worth Rs 13,900 were recovered from peddlers.

One currency note in the denomination of Rs 1000, 23 Rs 500 notes and two currency notes in the denomination of Rs 200 were recovered from them, sources said.

After the recovery of fake currency notes, officers of Border Security Forces

intelligence unit and other intelligence departments and Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) reached the police station and took details of the seizure.

The kingpin of gang of fake currency notes peddlers has been identified and he would be arrested soon, police added.
