Counterfeit 100 currency notes printing: Two held in East Godavari

Kakinada, Oct 30 (UNI) The Anaparty Circle Police have successfully nabbed a gang involved in printing and circulation of counterfeit currency notes of Rs 100 denomination by arresting two persons stated to be the kingpins.

Giving out the details of the case to media persons at Anaparty circle police station near here on Tuesday, the Sub Divisional Police Officer (SDPO) of Ramachandrapuram Santhosh said that both the accused – Kovvuri Srinivasareddy (34) and Dommeti Satish kumar (32) were involved in printing and circulation of the counterfeit currency using a colour printer.

Srinivasareddy resides in Devasthanam colony of Anaparty town while Satish is a resident of NTR colony in China Polamuru, a nearby village.

On October 27, Satish purchased a whiskey bottle at a wine shop in Polamuru and gave two counterfeit currency notes of Rs.100 denomination .

However the wine shop clerk suspected the genuineness of the currency and started verifying it. Meanwhile the accused fled away from the scene. Basing on the complaint lodged by the wine shop clerk the police registered a case and after a two day hunt, the accused were arrested this morning.

The police have seized 39 counterfeit Rs 100 notes and eleven counterfeit Rs 50 notes , a colour printer and a paper bundle at the residence of Dommeti Satish.

They also seized a bundle of one side printed counterfeit currency notes of Rs100 denomination containing 848 notes.

The SDPO said that the accused were sent for judicial remand. He has complimented the Sub-Inspector Srinivas and Circle Inspector Rajanikumar for the speedy detection of the case.
