## 3 held with counterfeit euros in Sion

MUMBAI: The crime branch arrested three persons from Sion with counterfeit euros with a face value of Rs 2.5 lakh. The police said that this is the first time that counterfeit foreign currency has been found in Mumbai.

The euro (€) is the official currency of 19 of 28 European Union member states, as well as some of its territories. It is

the second largest and second-most traded currency after the US\$.

The seizure has raised serious security concerns as the accused—Sandesh Sainath Khandagle (24), Swapnil Prakash Shinde (26) and Gaurav Dalvi

(28)—told the police they procured the counterfeit euros from the Dark Net. Senior inspector Santosh Revale said the accused have been booked under IPC sections of cheating and tampering with property mark with intent to cause injury. The police said the trio was remanded in police custody till October 22. Cops said a jeweller tipped them off about the suspects.
