Adilabad: Two persons belonging to Karnataka were arrested for carrying Rs 10 crore unaccounted cash in a four-wheeler at the inter-State check post on National Highway 44 at Pipperwada village in Jainath mandal on Friday.

Jainath Inspector T Swamy and Sub-Inspector Thota Thirupathi said the accused were Sarvesh Kumar and Vinod Shetti, the driver of the vehicle belonging to Tarkeri village of Chikmaguluru in Karnataka. It is learnt that the two are employees of a businessman from the neighbouring State.

Swamy and Thirupati along with other police were conducting vehicle check at the check post where they found the two moving about suspiciously. They failed to show relevant documents of the cash found in denominations of Rs 500 notes. On interrogation, they disclosed they were carrying the amount from Jam village in Maharashtra's Nagpur to Bengaluru.

Police said a case has been registered by Jainath cops and Swamy said the cash would be handed over the to the authorities of Income Tax department for further action.
