

# CG Big Breaking: Secrets uncovered then, here goes the hi-tech lab selling fake liquor

**Janjgir–Champa.** The Excise Department Chhattisgarh Government opened the government shops by abolishing the contractual practice, completely hightened the liquor sale system to close the kochia, but the illegal liquor vendors are two steps ahead of them.

Aklata ward number seven resident Javed Khan father Mo. Iqbal Khan (36) had set up a hi-tech lab selling fake liquor at his Khan Biriani Center and tasting shop on Shivrinarayan Road. With the help of computer, he used to make a fake level of the Excise Department and put it in the empty plane of the native plane and the mosque, and after buying liquor from liquor shop, adding water to it and selling it made 15 pav of 10 pav.

His [work](#) also included the liquor store staff. This illegal business was busted by Kalpana Rathore, a domineering sub-inspector of the Excise Department on Tuesday morning. Constable Santosh Rathore, Raman Nemi, Lakshmi Prasad Khande, Gopal Gupta and Raj Kumar Kashyap were also present with them during this action.

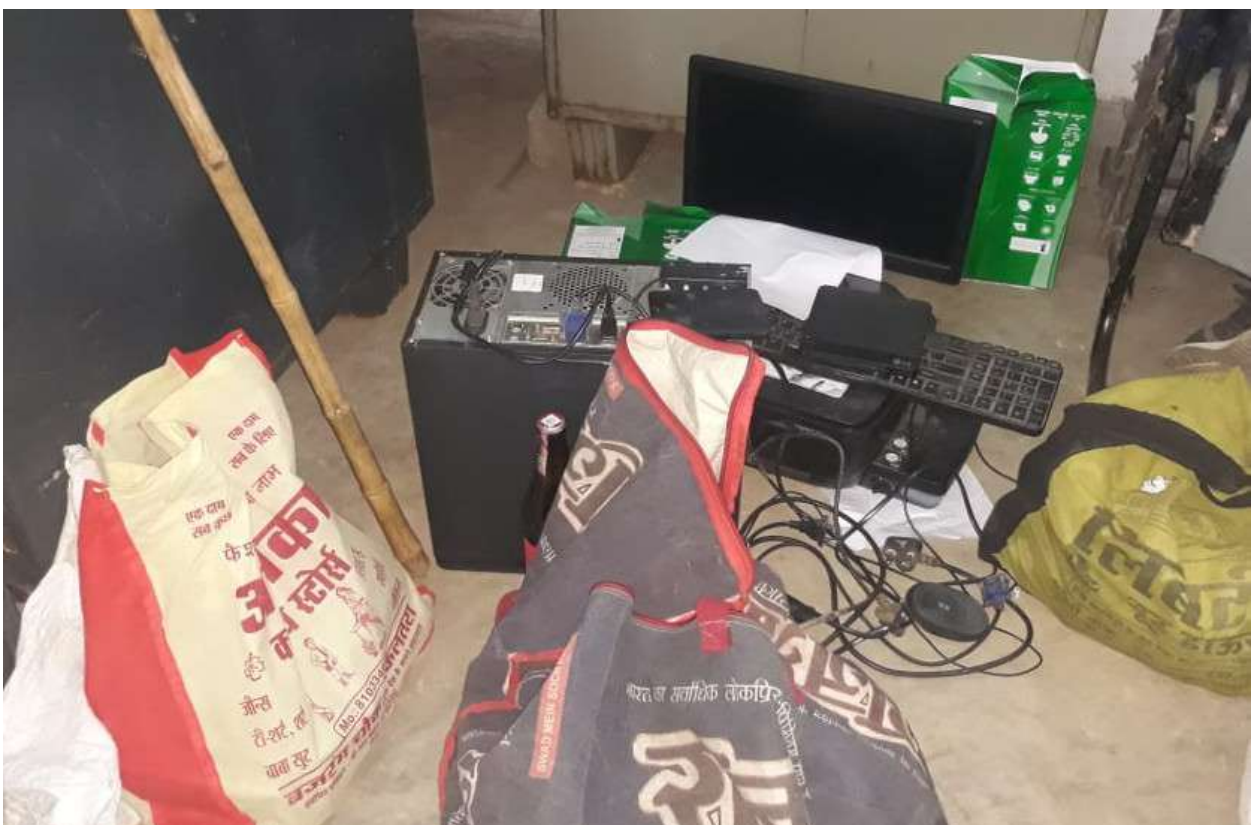
Kalpana Rathore, who **reached the accused in this way**, told the magazine in a special conversation that two–three days ago he caught Prem Bai, a resident of Akaltara Zahind Nagar, with 10 pav of liquor. When Kalpana Rathore saw that the seized liquor bottle had fake level and seal, she informed the Excise Assistant Commissioner Prakash Pal.

On the instructions of Prakash Pal, he lured the woman to act as a government witness instead. After this she reached Akaltara from Janjgir with her team at 6 am on Tuesday. He reached Prem Bai's house at 7.30 am and asked him to send liquor to Javed.

After calling around 10–15 times, Javed picked up the phone at 8.30 am and asked to send the goods. Kalpana Rathore immediately made a soldier stand on the railway over bridge. Made the two soldiers in the street and hid themselves in front of the woman's house. After some time, a young man named Sudama Pal arrived in a chickpea with liquor and no one suspected that he went straight into the mill,



Which makes people think that he has come to grind something. Kalpana Rathore's trap was already laid, they caught Sudama Dhar inside the mill and seized 12 pav of liquor from him after searching. There was also a fake level and seal in it.



After this, other soldiers also caught Javed Khan in a sold bike with Sudama. Both of them admitted to selling alcohol by adding fake levels and sealing them. The Excise team seized 74 POW country liquor, four counterfeit level slips, communicators, printers, net dongles etc. used for making slips from inside Javed Khan Biriani Center.

During the action, the Excise Department, along with **three accused, the Sales Man and Guard, also** took action during the action, including Javed Khan, Aurangabad Uttar Pradesh and Sudama Pal, a resident of Bajrang Chowk, father Lakshman (35), and Purushott Kumar, a resident of Akaltara, under Nagada police station, and Balram Ram Rathore (28) is arrested. The team of the Excise Department is also taking action against the salesmen and guards etc. of the government shop Akaltara on charges of providing liquor to these people at higher rates and rates.
