

# Fake notes seized; five held

RAJKOT: A total of 40 fake notes of Rs 2,000 and Rs 500 denominations were seized and five persons arrested in Chhalwavadar village of Dhoraji taluka in Rajkot district on Monday.

Police said that 36 counterfeit currency notes of Rs 2,000 denomination and four notes of Rs 500 denomination were found on Jatin Vaghela (27), Sagar Parmar alias Noori (26),

Vimal Solanki (28), Sanjay Chauhan (26) and Chintan Rawal (25).

“We arrested the accused on the basis of a tip-off about them working as carriers to circulate counterfeit currency in the market. The accused were nabbed from a cattle shed in Chhalwavadar. During interrogation, the accused said that they had procured the notes from an Ahmedabad-based person identified as Himanshu,” said Rajkot rural special operation group (SOG) inspector M N Rana.tnn
