Man held with counterfeit notes of over Rs 7 lakh face value

Man held with counterfeit notes of over Rs 7 lakh face value

Man held with counterfeit notes of over Rs 7 lakh face value New Delhi, Aug 11 (UNI) The Special Cell of Delhi Police has arrested a man with fake currency having a face value of more than Rs 7.5 lakh here.

"A team of Special Cell busted an international fake Indian currency notes (FICN) syndicate by arresting a man named Deepak Mandal (32)-- an active member of said syndicate and a resident of West Bengal-- at 2150 hrs on Thursday from near Khanpur Bus Stand of Delhi," a police official said on Saturday.

The official said that FICN of Rs 7.5 lakh, in the denomination of Rs 2,000 notes, was recovered from Mandal's possession.

The accused had brought these notes from a notorious FICN supplier of West Bengal's Malda, the official stated.
