

Bizman busted for aiding fake hand sanitiser production

HOME/BANGALORE/CRIME/BIZMAN BUSTED FOR AIDING FAKE HAND SANTISAE

A 53-year-old man, who was supplying chemicals to fake hand sanitiser manufacturing units, has been arrested. The accused's godown was raided on Sunday. Few life-threatening petroleum products have also been recovered.

The Central Crime Branch (CCB) sleuths who raided the godown has identified the accused as Renuka Prasad, a resident of BTM Layout 2nd stage. He is alleged to have

stored the items at a small godown on 1st main road in Sudhamanagar without a valid license.

The CCB sleuths have recovered few litres of isopropyl alcohol, nitrobenzene, silicone oil, liquid paraffin, methylene chloride, propylene glycol, polyethylene glycol and other chemicals. He is alleged to have been providing some of these chemicals to the manufacturers of fake hand sanitisers and other items.

"Some of the seized items are inflammable and was a threat to those living in the vicinity," said an investigating officer.

The Wilson Garden police have registered a case.
