

## Two arrested running an illegal sanitizer factory in Kaushambi

Two youths were caught from a house in Kaushambi. Along with this, 11 hundred liters of iso prophyte alcohol, including other chemicals, was recovered from the spot.

Prayagraj, J.N.N. In the neighboring Kaushambi district, in the Corona crisis, people are not deterred from taking advantage of the fear of epidemic. In Madpur village of Pooramufti area, the drug supervisor and the police team raided and raided a secretly operated sanitizer factory from Pakhwara. Chemical and equipment used in making sanitizer were recovered from the spot. Two people arrested. The police wrote the report and produced the accused in the court from where they were sent to jail.

## Sanitizer worth Rs 12 lakhs recovered

The house of Madhav resident Sanjeev Kumar Putra Ramshankar is on the roadside. This house was rented by two people for about 15 days. Both the young men used to secretly create sanitizers in the room through chemical. When Sallahpur outpost in-charge Sanjay Singh Parihar got information from the informer, he took the help of drug inspectors Govind Lal Gupta and Rahul Kumar on Tuesday and reached Madpur village with the police force. According to the post, two youths were caught from the house. Also, 11 hundred liters of iso-profite alcohol and other chemicals were recovered from the spot. The accused named their name as Mohammad Afzal son Afsar Ahmed resident Neem Sarai Mundera Dhumanganj Prayagraj and Amit Singh son Gulab Singh resident Paharpur Mau Chitrakoot. Both the accused told the police that they used to make sanitizer using chemical and used to sell the wrapper named Hygin in the vial.

## Supplies were also done in Prayagraj

Hundreds and two hundred grams of bottles were harvested in a fake sanitizer factory, caught at Madpur in Poramufti. The arrested accused told that he used to supply at Murtara, Dhumganj and Naini of Prayagraj including Muratganj, Manouri, Charava. Accused Amit said that he used to make fake Vakshg powder alone first. Four months ago, after meeting the sanitizer manufacturer Afzal, both of them started doing illegal business in one place and supplying to each other's customers. With this, the rent of the house along with Labor was also saved. Drug Inspector Rahul Kumar says that it is illegal to become a sanitizer without a license. The entire episode is being investigated. Departmental action will be taken.
