

# Punjab: 3 nabbed with counterfeit currency of Rs 6.5 lakh in Ropar

PATIALA: Ropar police on Friday has arrested three persons involved in counterfeit or [fake currency](#) and recovered an amount of Rs. 6.50 lakh of the counterfeit currency. The police said that fake currency notes of Rs 2000 were recovered from the accused.

The police have identified the accused as [Nand Lal](#) alias

Nandu of Ropar, Abhay Singh alias Tony of [Ambala](#) (Haryana) and Sushil Kumar alias Bunty of Ambala Cantt (Haryana).

The police also claimed to have recovered a cutter, one laptop and [Ertica](#) car No. HR-01AF-9953 from these accused and registered a case FIR No. 287 under sections of 489 A, 489 B, 489 C, 489 D, 120 B (criminal conspiracy) of Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Rupnagar. Akhil Chaudhary, SSP [Rupnagar](#) said that the further investigation was underway.
