

Maharashtra: Fake vaccination certificate racket busted in Thane, 4 held

THANE: The [Daighar](#) police recently busted a racket giving bogus vaccination certificates without giving jabs and arrested four persons. They have allegedly issued certificates to 100 citizens.

The accused are a part of a well-oiled cartel that was operating since the vaccination commenced earlier this year. On receiving information about the racket, the police laid a trap with a decoy. The police later found that the duo charged citizens Rs 1,000 to Rs 1,500, or even more, to give them a jab certificate.

“This is just the tip of the iceberg. So far around 100 such certificates have been issued. The probe is underway to track the other links in the case,” said a police officer on condition of anonymity.
