

Fake goods worth eight lakh seized

In the case of sale of fake cosmetic items of Hindustan Lever, on Thursday, police raided various shops in the city in the presence of the company's team from Bangalore and recovered fake cosmetic items worth about eight lakhs. This was confirmed by SHO-cum-Inspector of Police Shashibhushan Thakur. He said that shopkeepers Dinesh Kumar Sugauli, Sushil Kumar Mauje Raxaul, Virendra Prasad Shrirampur Raxaul, Brajkishore Das Mauje Raxaul and Mukesh Kumar Mauje Raxaul have been arrested in this connection. In this regard, the arrested shopkeeper has been sent to Motihari judicial custody after registering a case under the Copyright Act along with other criminal sections. After the raid, there has been a stir in the shopkeepers selling counterfeit goods. It was then revealed that sales were being affected due to the sale of counterfeit goods in the city. After that this raid has been done. The raid included lipsticks, kajal and other valuable cosmetic items.
