



Fake certificates

- Certificates from 18 universities in 13 states
- 11 people arrested..70 certificates seized
- Manhunt for three accused from West Bengal

City Bureau, July 29 (Namaste Telangana): Cyberabad, Madapur SOT and KPHB police have arrested an interstate gang producing fake certificates. The investigation revealed that this gang is preparing fake certificates of 18 universities and 10 inter boards in 13 states from inter to PG. Out of this 14-member gang, 11 people were arrested, including those who obtained fake certificates.

CP Stephen Ravindra disclosed the details in a press conference organized at the Cyberabad Police Commissionerate office. Munagara Venkateswara Rao, a native of Bhimadol, West Godavari district, came to the city less than three months ago and is staying at Krishna Chaitanya Hostel in KPHB Colony. In this order, hostel warden Krishnakanth Reddy alias Nani came to know and asked him to tell me if there is any job with inter qualification.

"What job do you do with Inter..? If you have a degree certificate, you will get good jobs', he assured that if you want, he will give you an original degree certificate from a good university. He took Rs.90 thousand and presented a BCom certificate from Chaudhary Charan Singh University of Meerut, Uttar Pradesh. But when Venkateswara Rao inquired about the certificate, it was found to be fake and approached the police.

Fake certificates for about 100 people

When the police interrogated Krishnakanth Reddy, they said Kota Kishore of Vijayawada had given them fake certificates through Bocca Venkateswara Rao and Kurella Kirankumar. On further investigation it was found that Kishore was supplying one sitting degree certificate from several universities.

Among them are Thimmu Madhukar (Nirmal), Relacharla Gopal Krishna (Khammam), Bairagani Rajesh Goud (Kondapur), Rondla Devender Reddy (Yusufguda), Kudeti Krishnasai (Bachupally), Ava Raghavendra Gupta (Balanagar), Sheikh Babagous (Kukatpally) and about It was found that fake certificates were supplied to 100 people. 11 people were arrested by the police.

Made in West Bengal..!

Meanwhile the police detained Kishore and interrogated him. Kishore was doing a private job in Vijayawada. I lost my job during the Corona epidemic. Later, he started a consultancy called Campus Services, which would send jobs and send them abroad. In this order, he searched for one sitting degree certificates on Google and contacted Sanjay Verma, Rahul Ghosh and Pratima Patil from West Bengal. Rs. 1.5 lakh to Rs. He took up to 2.5 lakhs and entered into an agreement to supply certificates.

After Kishore placed the order and sent the money, the certificate was sent by courier from Bengal to the person's home. However, the police have arrested 11 of the 14 accused and are looking for three accused from West Bengal. 70 fake certificates, fake stamps and other items were recovered from the main accused who were arrested.
