

Fake fern in the name of a famous company: Those who made and sold it were arrested



Chennai police have arrested people who were manufacturing and selling fake ferns in the name of famous fern company LG fern

LG Perungayam is very popular all over Tamil Nadu including Chennai. Some people who came to know about this have been making fake fern powder in the name of LG fern and selling it all over Tamil Nadu in cans with similar labels. Due to this, even from many towns, the quality of bamboo is not good. Complaints went to Company G.

Subsequently, Sathish Varkar from LG Perungayam Company met Chennai Police Commissioner Shankar Jiwal in person and filed a complaint. It said, 'some people are using our company's name illegally to produce fake ferns and sell them in Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh. Due to the use of this fake aloe there is danger to the body and life of the people.

Therefore, action should be taken against those who use the name of our company to manufacture and sell fake bamboo. Based on this complaint, a special team was formed and an investigation was underway. 15 places in Chennai's Vannarappat and Korukuppet areas were found to be producing and selling fake eucalyptus. After this, special forces police conducted raids in these places.

In their search, Janpeter (49), Ravi (58), Manikandan (32), Satish (30) from Korukuppet area, Selvaraj (72), Ramalingam (76), Sumathi (42) from Vannarpet area, Shamshad Ilad (32) from Thandaiarpet area.), Srinivasan (35) from Kodunkaiyur and Kanaram (48) from MKP Nagar were arrested.
