Gang making fake purifiers arrested



Jedimetla, April 1: Balanagar SOT, Kukatpally, KPHB police have caught a gang who were manufacturing and selling fake water purifiers used for clean water. DCP Srinivasa Rao disclosed the details along with SOT Additional DCP Sobhan in a press conference organized at Balanagar DCP office on Saturday. For a few days, fake water filter purifiers of water purifiers belonging to famous companies Count, Aguaguard, HUL were found in the shops of Sharada Enterprises Mahankalinagar, Kookatpally, Blue Aqua Water Solution KPHB, Limpid Enterprises KPHB in Kookatpally, KPHB police station area. Manufactured and sold. They are selling them to the customers who come to the shops as they are doing repairs and services. The customers who bought them said that the water treatment is not being done properly, recently the representatives of those companies went to the respective shops and inquired after a complaint from a customer. It was found that fake products were being manufactured there and a complaint was lodged with the police. As a result, the police, who entered the field, seized the fake products, trademark stickers and other equipment brought from them from Delhi. He said that the value of these will be around Rs.10 lakhs. Accused Rinku, Navi, Shravan and Nishad have been detained by the police. While the main accused Pradeep Jain is absconding. Balanagar SOT Inspector Rahuldev, Kukatpally Inspector Narsinga Rao, KPHB Inspector Kishan and others were present in this press conference.
