

Over 500 kg of adulterated ghee seized by food department in Vapi-Umargam GIDC

A team of the Food and Drugs Department has called a crackdown on adulterated traders during the festive season. The team of food department has seized quantity of low quality ghee from Vapi and Umargam of Valsad district and issued notice to the traders. Wound samples of Rangamadhur cows were collected from Charanamrut Dairy located in Umargam GIDC. The Food and Drugs Department has seized 500 kg of ghee worth Rs 3.13 lakh after finding the sample to be of low quality.



Valsad: A team of Food and Drugs Department has called a crackdown on adulterated traders on the occasion of festivals. The team of food department has seized quantity of low quality ghee from Vapi and Umargam of Valsad district and issued notice to the traders. Wound samples of Rangamadhur cows were collected from Charanamrut Dairy located in Umargam GIDC.

The Food and Drugs Department has seized 500 kg of ghee worth Rs 3.13 lakh after finding the sample to be of low quality. Along with this, checking was also done at Jashnath Traders in Kachigam. Samples of Saran Premium Cow Ghee and Vastu Eggmark Ghee were taken from there.

After this sample was also found to be adulterated, 33 kg of ghee worth 21 thousand was seized. How much low quality ghee has been supplied from Charanamrut dairy running in Umargam GIDC since last 7 years. Investigation is being done in that direction.
