₹15L fake medicines seized from Pinjore unit, 4 arrested



Panchkula: The CM flying squad has busted a fake allopathy medicine manufacturing unit operating from a house at Ghatiwala village in Pinjore, with the arrest of four people and seized spurious medicines worth Rs 15 lakh. The accused have been identified as Amit Dua, a resident of Himshikha Colony, Pinjore; Rajnikant, a resident of Bilaspur, Himachal Pradesh; Mohd Afzal, a resident of Badaun, Uttar Pradesh; and Ajay Kumar, a resident of Morena, Madhya Pradesh.

Officials said the action was taken on a tip-off. The accused could not produce any drug licence required for manufacturing and sale of allopathic drugs. Another illegal manufacturing unit of the accused was sealed in Bargodam village, Pinjore. A huge quantity of spurious allopathic drugs, loose capsules and tablets were seized. The officials said, "All seized medicines are worth Rs 15 lakh." Police registered a case under Sections of Copyright Act and IPC.
