

Manufacturing and sale of illicit liquor in Nagapattinam, 3 held



Nagapattinam: Police personnel attached to Prohibition Enforcement Wing (PEW) arrested three people for manufacturing and selling illicit liquor in Nagapattinam district of Tamil Nadu on Saturday.

The accused identified as Suresh, Giri and Kaliamoorthy were distilling and selling illicit liquor at Vettaikaraniruppu and its neighbouring villages.

The PEW personnel and police team destroyed over 100 liters of raw liquor and materials used for manufacturing country liquor.

Similarly, according to a tip-off received on the phone number to the control room, the police seized more than 100 bottles of Puducherry state liquor stashed in the outdoor Nalliyam garden in the district.

Superintendent of Police Harsh Singh said that various measures are being taken to prevent the sale and smuggling of liquor in the district. He warned that those involved in serial selling and smuggling would be arrested under the Gangster Prevention Act.
