Gurgaon: 14 held in raid on co selling fake herbal supplements



GURGAON: Fourteen people were arrested on Friday for running a fake herbal supplement company at an office- cum- call centre in Udyog Vihar. The accused sold fake herbal sexual wellness supplements via online, police said. After a tip-off, a team of Cyber West police conducted a raid at the call centre. Samples of the seized herbal products will be sent to FSL for analysis. "The office cum call centre of AV Herbarium, a company involved in selling herbal sexual medicines online, was raided.

Our police team arrested 14 accused, including two owners and five women, from the call centre," DCP South Siddhant Jain said. Abhay Shukla and Vaibhav Shukla were identified as the owners of the company, while Ujjwal Kumar Singh, Balram, Vikas Pattihari, Rahul, Wasim Akram, Priyanshu, Vishal, Rachna Srivastava, Monica, Shikha Thakur, Babli, and Shashi were employees. "During the interrogation, it came to light that the employees had been putting up as to sell herbal sexual medicines online on the instructions of Abhay Shukla. When people called the phone numbers on the ads, the employees took orders, collected money via UPI, and sent fake herbal products. They do not have permits from any govt agency to run this facility," the DCP said.
