Nilgiris, July 24: Copyright officials conducted inspections in many shops in Nalgonda town on Wednesday. Police under the supervision of Copyrights Mumbai officials and Onetown CI Ehireddy Rajasekhar Reddy conducted checks against the managers who were selling low quality electric wires to the public under branded name.

Managers at Hanuman Electrical shop in Prakasam Bazar raided on information received that they were selling substandard electric wires in the name of Gold Medal Company and seized 16 bags of wires worth around Rs 22 lakh. Also, seven boxes worth about 1.21 lakh worth of fake agarbattis in the name of Stevewell Company were seized from the Padmavati Kiranam General Store in Sherbangla in the town and a case was registered.

Later, Onetown CI Ehireddy Rajasekhar Reddy said that Madan and Srinivas, who were selling substandard goods that are harmful to the people, are being detained and are being investigated. IP Investigation Officer Izrar, SI Sandeep Reddy, Shankar, Copyright Officers Iqbal Qadri, Dinesh Shetty, Santhosh and Deepak were present in the program.
