

Hyderabad: Suspected spurious drugs worth Rs. 20.52 lakh seized



Hyderabad: The <u>Drugs Control Administration (DCA)</u>, Telangana conducted raids on Thursday and Friday at an unlicensed godown in Amberpet and seized stocks of medicines worth Rs. 20.52 lakh, which are suspected to be spurious/counterfeit and were meant for illegal sale supply to government hospitals.

The DCA drug inspectors raided the godown located near Ali Cafe, Azad Nagar, Amberpet, being operated by Md. Basheer Ahmed without any drug licence and was allegedly carrying out illegal sale of medicines, and seized several cardboard shipper cartons containing huge quantity of medicines.
