Fake FMCG brands factory raided, products worth Rs. 1.8 cr seized



Bengaluru: Acting on a tip-off, Central Crime Branch (CCB) sleuths raided a unit manufacturing fake branded consumer products like detergents and tea powder and its godowns in Machohalli, off Magadi Road in West Bengaluru. They seized nearly Rs 1.8 crore worth counterfeit products of companies like Lizol, Harpic, Colin, Tide Powder, Wheel detergent, Surf Excel, 3 Roses Tea and Red Label Tea. The police arrested a distributor, Dalapat Singh, in his 30s and are making efforts to nab the factory owner, Vimal Singh, who is at large. Srinivas S, an employee of a private firm representing Godrej Consumer Products, filed a complaint with CCB police on Jan 29, stating that during a market survey, his team found fake products of Good Knight mosquito repellents, Ariel and Tide detergents, and All Out mosquito repellents, being illegally sold in a few shops in Kurubarapete of Subhashnagar in Cottonpet. They collected more information about the products and found that Dalapat was supplying fake products to the shops, claiming they were genuine.
