Nagpur: A shortage of NCERT textbooks has led to the arrest of a city-based bookseller for allegedly stocking and selling counterfeit copies. Around 189 duplicate books, worth over Rs24,000, were seized on Monday from a bookshop on Tilak Road. The accused, Jaikishan Binzhani (36), owner of the book depot, was booked by Kotwali police under Sections 51 and 63 of the Copyright Act, 1957, following a complaint lodged by NCERT assistant professor Venkata Suryavanshi (41), who is based in Bhopal.
